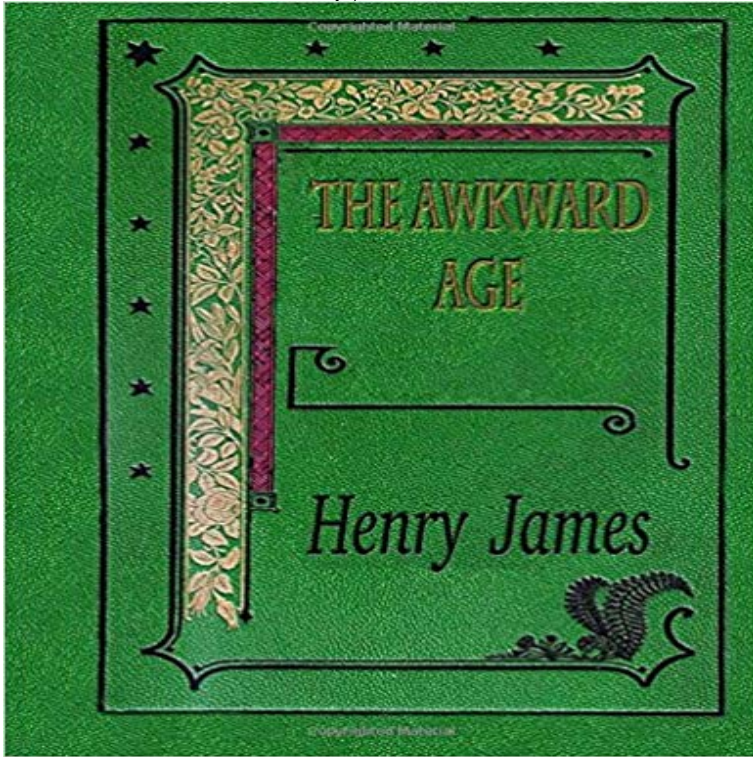


The Awkward Age
