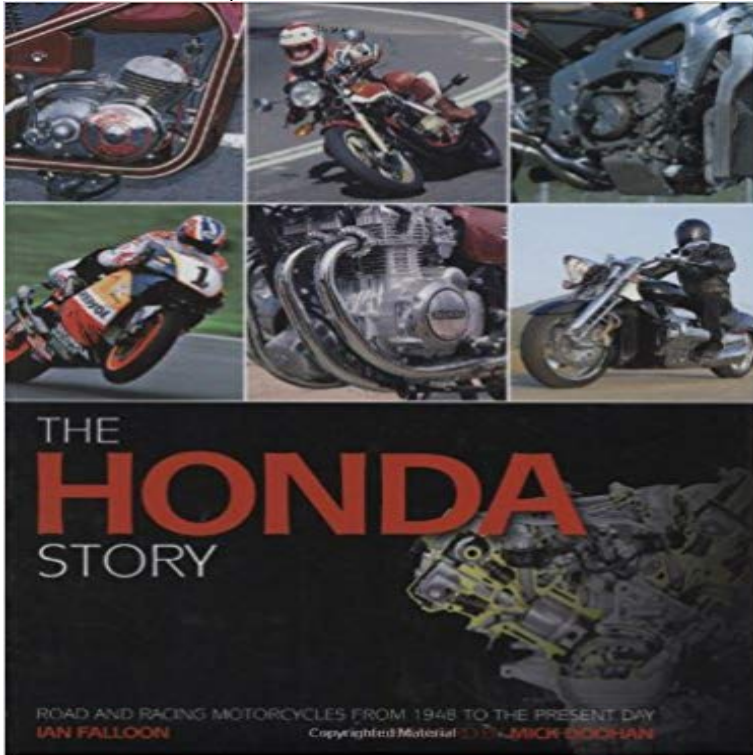


# The Honda Story: Road And Racing Motorcycles From 1948 To The Present Day
